



Camping Le Célé – House Rules

Welcome to Camping Le Célé!

To ensure a pleasant and relaxing stay for everyone, please observe the following rules:

Respect for Fellow Campers

Be considerate of others' privacy and comfort. A respectful and friendly atmosphere benefits everyone.

Quiet Hours: 10:00 PM – 8:00 AM

Please keep noise to zero during these hours. If arriving after 10:00 PM, park at the small lot to the right of the roundabout.

Children

Children must always be supervised by an adult—especially near the playground, river, pool, and in the sanitary areas.

Pets

Pets are welcome on a leash and under control at all times. Owners must clean up after their pets. Note: Dogs in categories 1 & 2 are not permitted.

Your Pitch

Keep your pitch clean and tidy. Digging into the ground is not allowed.

Waste Disposal

Separate your waste in the bins near the road entrance at the mainroad:

- Cardboard
- Glass
- Green (deposit bottles/cans)
- Brown (general waste)

No grey water or chemical toilet disposal available.

Facilities

Use all sanitary facilities responsibly:

- Keep them clean
- Close doors gently
- Turn off taps and lights
- Toilets are for toilet use only
- Showers are for showering only

**Drinking Water**

Tapwater is drinkabel. Let it run briefly before drinking.

Barbecues & Fires

Barbecues are allowed only in the designated area (right of the main parking).

No open fires allowed. Please notify us before using the BBQ. Keep a big bucket of water nearby.

Driving & Parking

Drive slowly (walking speed) for safety. One vehicle per pitch. After 10:00 PM, park at the roundabout lot.

Safety & Emergencies

- Follow all staff instructions
- We are not responsible for lost/damaged belongings
- House rules and evacuation plans are posted in the sanitary blocks and at reception

In Case of Emergency:

- Stay calm and alert campsite staff
- Call 112 (EU emergency)
- Evacuate if needed by staff and follow staff instructions
- Use marked evacuation routes and go to the assembly area (terras campside)
- Keep ID and insurance documents close at hand
